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
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Foreword




National Cadet Corps (NCC)

Rules & Regulations

New session/Semester joining Policy

The Students are expected to join the new academic session/semester as per the academic calendar specified by affiliating university. The starting date of academic session/semester would be notified much in advance and would be communicated orally as well as through the official notice. New students should visit the website www.cgc.edu.in or should interact with admission office/HOD of their course to know the date of starting of the academic session. Late joiners would be penalized as per the policy of the institute. In case of genuine exigency, a prior permission can be taken from the head of the department (HOD).

Dress Code

Different colleges/departments would have their dress code and the same would be communicated to the students at the time of admission.

Different colleges/departments would specify and notify the days on which students would be expected to be in the uniform. In addition to the days generally specified it is also expected that students must wear uniform on all important occasions when there are functions/ guest lectures/ placement drives in their respective colleges/departments.

The students who are not in full uniform on pre-specified days would be penalized as per the policy of the institute.

Students should be dressed in a presentable manner inside the campus on all working days. Wearing Chappals, Sport shoes, Skirt, Shorts and Kurta Pajama, Patkas or Bermudas is strictly forbidden during college time.

Attendance Mechanism

A student is advised to give 100% attendance right from the 1st day of the semester. A student must adhere the criteria of minimum of 75% attendance in all subjects

(theory and practical separately) taught during a semester to become eligible for appearing in the final end semester examination & sessionals.

To ensure this, attendance would be collected and analyzed after every 15 days. If a student falls short of 75% attendance in any subject during a fortnight, his parents will be intimated regarding the same'

Leave Policy

'No student should be absent from the class without prior permission. Leave, if required, must be taken in advance from the respective HOD. Applications for leave on Medical grounds should be supported by medical certificates. However, leave of any kind including leave on medical grounds cannot be accepted as a reason for not complying with the attendance requirement. As per rules, Director may condone a maximum of 10% shortage of attendance on medical or other grounds (subject to a minimum of 75% attendance).

Grievance Committee

Chandigarh Group of Colleges has a very fair, just, and accessible Grievance Redressal System to cater to the various complaints of students ranging from ragging, verbal abuse, any kind of mental, sexual, physical, or emotional harassment, concerns like

thefts, fights, brawls, etc. Students are provided solutions to every problem in the shortest possible time. Three dedicated and vigilant committees: Student Grievance Redressal Committee, Anti-Ragging Committee, and Internal Complaint Committee provide 24 hrs support to

the students. The complaints can be filled through both online and offline modes. Every year students are well informed about the procedure during the Orientation program conducted at the beginning of every session.
